



Carbon Pollution Reduction Scheme – Green Paper Regional Information Sessions Corrigendum to Climate Change Household Advertising Campaign Evaluation Report

The Department of Climate Change consulted widely on the Carbon Pollution Reduction Scheme Green Paper.

A series of public information sessions were run across Australia in all capital cities and 11 regional centres being Latrobe Valley, Geelong, Whyalla, Kalgoorlie, Cairns, Townsville, Mackay, Gladstone, Burnie, Wollongong and Newcastle. In total more than 400 people attended the regional information sessions.
