<sup>2</sup> Schools that received part-funding under an NSSP Co-operative Delivery Arrangement with the Qld Department of Education and Training are eligible for a maximum of \$25,000 less the amount of NSSP funding already received. Schools that have received their full NSSP entitlement under a Co-operative Delivery Arrangement are not eligible for further funding.
